Cultivation and storage (point of attention)

Seed treatment	Normal pre-sprouting
Plot selection	Good soils are preferred
Fertilisation	N + P ± K +
Planting	Slightly narrow planting distance and slightly deep planting
Cultivation	Good structure of soil is required
Metribuzin	Average sensitive
Harvesting	Harvest in time, to avoid second growth
Storage	Good storability
Handling	Easy handling
Point of Attention	To avoid second growth, regular sampling is required
